



Parents, please read through carefully and discuss with your child/ren so that they have a good idea of what to expect and understand the new, very different routines at school.

- Please ensure temperature is taken and checked each morning before leaving for school. If this is higher than normal please inform school and stay at home. Similarly, if for any reason your child is unable to attend school please notify the school through the usual procedure. If anyone in the household has COVID symptoms then children **MUST** not attend school.
- Only **one** parent must accompany child/ren to and from school. Children can be taken to the classroom outside door but parents must not enter the classroom.
- Children should be dressed in school uniform but no ties for Year 6 (at the moment) as these cannot be washed
- Please observe 2 m social distancing at all times - we need to minimise contact between individuals and maintain social distancing wherever possible
- Please observe 2 m distancing markings on pathways leading up to the school and on playground. Driveway double gates will be open for a one way system
- Miss Allsop and the office staff will be at the gate each morning as normal
- Children to arrive and depart through the classroom door
- On arrival line up immediately outside the classroom door observing social distancing and wait to be invited to move forward or enter the classroom
- On entering the classroom go directly to your table and sit down
- Children will be asked to wash their hands regularly throughout the day including after arrival and encouraged when they are moving around the school to clasp their hands together to avoid accidentally touching surfaces.
- **Do not** bring a bag to school; you will need:
 - * a sun hat or coat
 - * a water bottle (clearly labelled)
 - * a small bottle of hand sanitizer if possible (this will also be available in the classroom)
 - * a lunch box if you are not having a school dinner
 - * a piece of fruit for snack in a sealed bag
 - * a reading book
- Lay out your water bottle and hand sanitizer on your table, with the resource pack that school will provide for you
- Keep your lunch box, hat and/or coat under the table. School items will be kept in your tray.
- Children must not share food or drink with others.
- Sun cream must be applied by parents before arrival at school if required
- The classroom may be different. The teacher will stay at the front of the classroom.
- Toilets will be allocated to each class family and children will go one at a time to the toilets
- If you need to cough or sneeze you **must** use a tissue (these will be provided at school) and place the tissue in the lidded bin in the classroom
- Break times and lunch times will be staggered (different for each class family) and lunch will be eaten in the classroom
- Children will not be able to play freely with children from other class families at break time or lunchtime as this increases contact and transmission risk. Instead, each class family will have a designated part of the playground and field which they can use
- Children must follow the school's rules and expectations to keep them safe both when in school and when working online when using remote learning (please read and sign the code of behaviour and home school agreement and return one copy to school)
- Minimise as far as possible the number of education and childcare settings a child attends. ***It is important to advise parents to limit the number of different wraparound providers they access. Where parents use childcare providers or out of school activities for their children, schools should encourage them to seek assurance that the providers are carefully considering their own protective measures, and only use those providers that can demonstrate this.***

Above all, all children should demonstrate their usual respectful behaviour towards each other and adults. They should try their best to ensure the health and safety of others by following the teacher's instructions to avoid unnecessary contact. Thank you
