During these unusual and challenging times it is necessary for us to adjust our expectations for behaviour of children whilst in school in order to reduce potential risks and keep all children and staff as safe as possible.

Please read through the guidelines for behaviour in school outlined below and discuss together at home and then sign and return one copy to school

•I agree that any member of the family will access a Covid 19 test should they display any symptoms

Whilst in school I agree to:

- •follow the instructions and boundaries set by any adults working with me
- •follow instructions on which children I can socialise with at school (those in my teaching group)
- •move around the school as instructed following any signs and routes marked out
- •do my best to keep to the rules of social distancing
- •avoid and contact misbehaviour eg. hitting, kicking, spitting
- •only use my own equipment and resources that have been allocated to me
- •follow rules about sharing any equipment or other items including drinking bottles
- •wash my hands regularly and thoroughly
- •avoid coughing or sneezing near another person and I will 'catch it, bin it, kill it' if I sneeze or cough and use tissues. I will not spit
- •avoid touching my mouth, nose and eyes with hands
- •tell an adult if I feel unwell in any way

If I am remote learning at home I agree to:

be fully dressed (no pyjamas)
work in a communal room in my house (not my bedroom)
respect others in the group

We have read and discussed these rules together and agree to follow them
