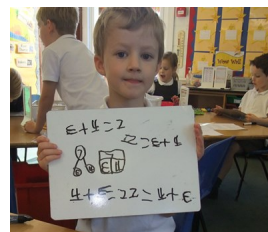
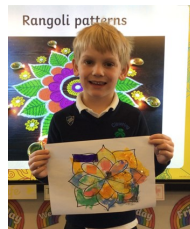
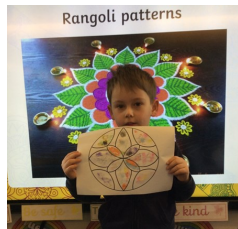


CLASS ONE

In Religious Education, Class 1 enjoyed exploring all about Diwali (The Festival of Light) this half term. In Geography, Class 1 have enjoyed looking at different types of weather and weather patterns seen during different seasons.
