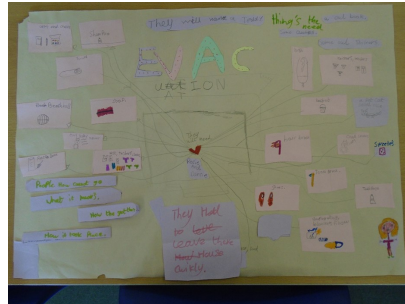
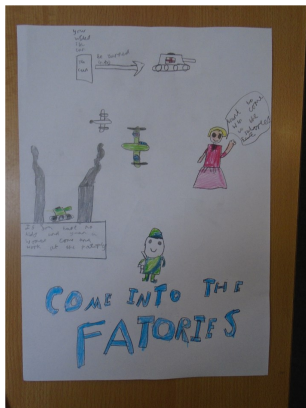
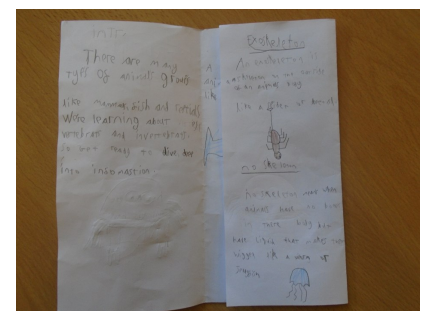
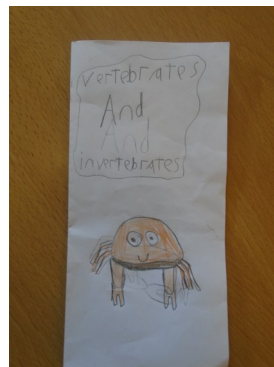
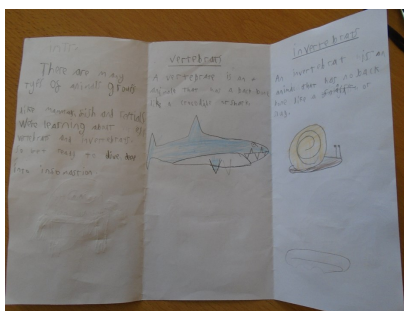


## CLASS 4

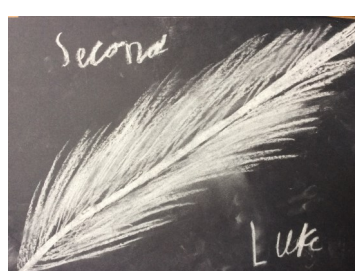
