
We loved our trip to Audley End to visit Father Christmas on the train. A huge thank you to the parents for transporting the children to and from Audley End.

CLASS I

In Class 1 we have been observing and enjoying time in our natural surroundings. In science we have been learning about our most recent season, Autumn. We learnt about the months autumn occurs in and the weather expected then, we also went out into the school grounds and had a look at the changes that happen during autumn. Then we drew our own autumnal pictures and tried a challenge describing what happens in autumn.

We have also enjoyed our first forest school session where we got to enjoy playing the autumn leaves and building dens!



In Science, class 2 have been looking at living things are their habitats. The children have learnt the mnemonic MRS GREN to help them remember the 7 processes all livings things do—movement, respiration, sensitivity, growth, reproduce, excrete and nutrition. The children used this knowledge to find items outside that were either alive, dead or never been alive. They recorded their findings into their books.
