RECEPTION

We have been enjoying our new Space topic hearing lots of stories set in space and reading a range of exciting non-fiction books too.

We explored two stories about aliens and were inspired by the illustrations in Here Come the Aliens By Colin McNaughton to design our own aliens. The children drew them first by hand then used the sketch app on the iPads to edit and add detail to their first ideas.



After this, they all created a name, planet of origin and a description of their alien. Our focus in writing at the moment is to use our phonics to spell words and to leave spaces between our words to help the reader!


fun.



We then tried to draw our own aboriginal animals using the technique of cross hatching. After trying the technique, we added colour to our animals.







CLASS 2

In Class 2, for Science, we have continued our topic of 'Materials'. Last week the children predicted whether we could squash, bend, twist and stretch a selection of materials. This week the children tested the materials to find out whether they could and if their predictions were correct. The children tested a drinks can, pipe cleaner, Lego, sock, elastic band, plastic pot, a towel, sponge and a hair clip.












CLASS 3
