
CLASS 3









CLASS 5

Shahadah- The declaration of faith.

Zakah - Give 2.5% of earnings to charity.

Sawm - fasting: not eating or drinking for a month between sunrise and sunset.

Hajj - Making a journey once in your lifetime to a special place called Mecca.
