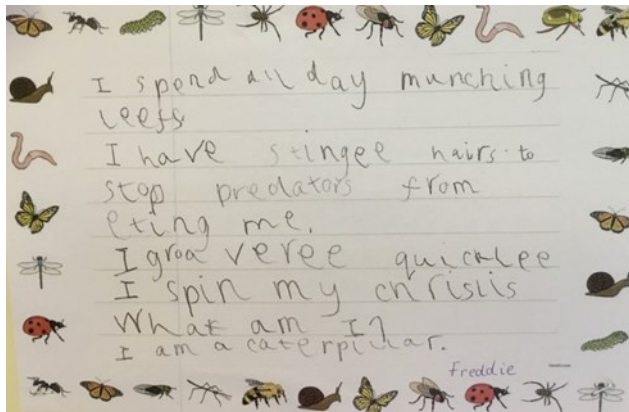
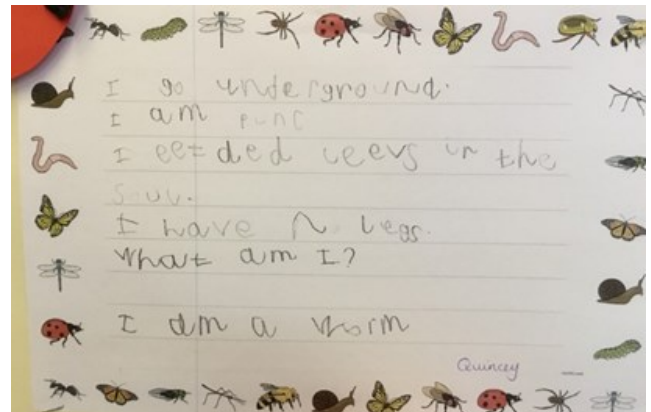


# RECEPTION

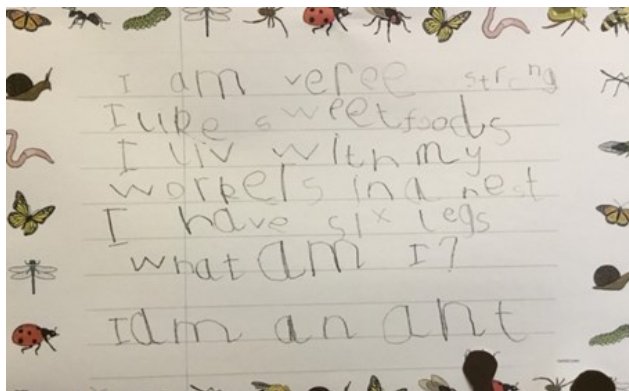
We enjoyed reading and writing a riddle about a minibeast. It was fun to come up with clues and consider the order of the clues without giving too much away too soon.



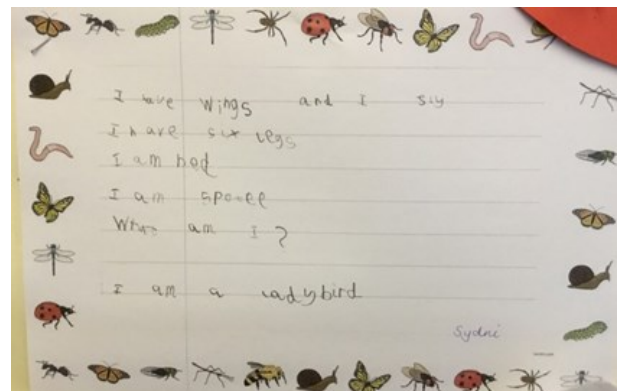

# CLASS 1

In Class 1 we have been learning about multiplication and division in maths. We have learnt how to divide by grouping a given number into specifically sized groups and counting the number of groups (e.g. group 20 into \_\_\_\_ groups of 2), and sharing a given number into a specified number of groups and counting how many items are in each group (e.g. group 20 into 2 groups of \_\_\_\_). We practiced these skills practically using cubes to try and get a better understanding.

Next they stuffed with it with toy stuffing before creating hair out of wool. The children had some help sewing it closed.
