Here's an overview of how and where the money we raised this term has been spent:

- £250 for outside equipment
- £1500 The children have enjoyed music lessons throughout the year through the Wider Ops Scheme
- £500 the Religious Education syllabus has recently changed and the FoC Supported the school to purchase the necessary educational
- An additional £1000 is going into the growing pot to raise funds to buy laptops and ipads for the school

Next year we'll continue to support school events, helping to raise vital funds for IT equipment so that multiple classes can have access to laptops and iPads.
