



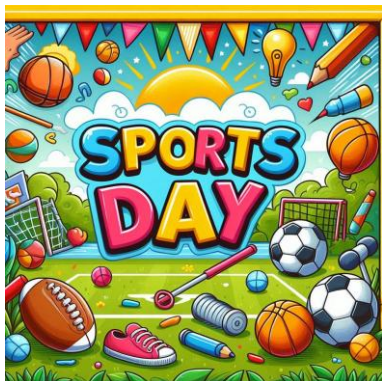
# THE FRIDAY FOCUS
